- 4 How was your life with a lion? / What was it like living with a lion?
- 5 Did you know that living with a wild animal would not last long?
- 6 What made you decide to let the lion go back to Africa?
- 7 When you saw Christian again in Africa, did you think he remembered you?
- 8 What did you learn from Christian?
- 9 What did you get from Christian and what did you give to him, if anything?
